Subject: Student Preparation in academic year 2018

As Prince of Songkla University has announced the names of the students who are eligible to enroll at Phuket Campus in academic year 2018, the following details are specified to ensure that the new students are well prepared.

1. Report Change of Address (Students residing in Thailand only)

To abide by the Phuket Announcement; Subject: To report a change of address in accordance with the Civil Registration Law dated 28 January B.E. 2541; and the Civil Registration Act B.E. 2543, as well as to consider the students' rights such as voting; requesting for an identity card; a health insurance card; and a copy of a house registration, Prince of Songkla University requires all eligible enrolled students to report a change of address at the district office, where their house registration issued, as follows:

Then the eligible enrolled students should keep a copy of their change of address form and submit two original copies of the change of address form to Division of Student Affairs, second floor, Office of the President, Phuket Campus, between now and on 15th September 2018.

Eligible enrolled students who wish to apply for a student loan (Kor. Yor. Sor.) must register to confirm their application via www.studentloan.or.th before reporting a change of house registration; otherwise their application might be affected.

Those who fail to record their own personal profile accurately and completely within a required date will not be allowed to register as a student of the university.

14. Student Uniform

Female students

- 1. White shirt with no designs, not transparent, respectable and not too close-fitting. No pictures or printed words. Shirt-tail worn inside skirt. The ends of short sleeves must be above the chest. Please wear the badge and buttons of the university.
- 2. Navy blue or dark skirt, opaque, no designs or lace, must be at least knee-length.
- 3. Black or brown leather belt with the symbol of the university on a buckle.
- 4. Dark or white respectable court shoes, no sandals

Male students

- 1. White shirt with no designs or pictures or printed words, shirt tail worn inside trousers
- 2. Dark, formal trousers.

- 3. Black or brown leather belt with the symbol of the university on a buckle.
- 4. Dark formal shoes with no designs. Dark socks. No sandals.

Student outfits for specific occasions

Students are allowed to wear some outfits that are convenient for them when having a workshop. This is to abide by faculty's or program's regulations. Shirts, skirts, and trousers are sold at the male student dormitory while badges and T-shirts for student activities are sold at the female student dormitories 1 and 2 from now onwards.
