## Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus

Subject: Admission for Overseas High-School Graduates

for the Academic Year 2018

Prince of Songkla University (PSU) would like to announce the admission process for students who have completed their high school overseas to study at Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus, Thailand for the academic year 2018 as follows:

## 1. Qualifications

An applicant must:

- 1.1 Be an overseas high-school graduate with one of the following graduation certificates: High School Diploma or its equivalent or IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) or GED (General Educational Development) or IB (International Baccalaureate),
- 1.2 Be free from common infectious diseases or other serious illnesses,
- 1.3 Be well-mannered,
- 1.4 Meet all the requirements as described in the table below:

1.5 For those who do not meet all the required qualifications 1.1 – 1.4 above, your admission application may be considered by the Admissions Committee on a case-by-case basis.

## 2. Application Procedures

- 2.1 Applicants must choose only one major
- 2.2 Applicants must provide the following support documents\*:
  - 2.2.1 A completed application form
  - 2.2.2 A certified copy of high school diploma and transcript of record or a certified copy of one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED or IB
  - 2.2.3 A certificate of English Proficiency Test (TOEIC, TOEFL or IELTS)
  - 2.2.4 A certified copy of identification card (for Thais) or passport (for non-Thais)
  - 2.2.5 A certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if any)
- 2.3 Applicants may apply through the following 2 channels with a completed payment of application fee of 800 baht:
  - 2.3.1 By Online Application (starting from December 22, 2017 July 3, 2018 at midnight)

# 2.3.2 In Person (starting from December 22, 2017 – July 3, 2018 at midnight)

- An application form can be picked up at the Admissions and Registration Office on the  $1^{\rm st}$  floor of Building 7 (the President's Office Building), Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus, Kathu, Phuket (Monday Friday, 8:30 am 4:30 pm). Be sure to bring along all required support documents stated above (2.2.2 2.2.5) with you.
- A non-refundable application fee payment of 800 baht must be paid at the Financial Section by July 4, 2018 before 3.00 pm. (Please check the accuracy of your payment.
   Once you have submitted payment for application, the university is unable to refund your application fee).

Notes: 1. All required documents must be in <u>English only</u> (documents in other languages must be translated into English with an official stamp).

2. All copies of documents must be certified copies.

## 3. Application and Notification Periods

The application and notification periods are scheduled from December 22, 2017 - July 3, 2018. Classes will begin on August 14, 2018.

## 4. Admission Criteria and Conditions

The University will appoint the Admissions Committee to select the qualified applicants. The applicants applying to study at the Faculty of Hospitality and Tourism will be interviewed in English. Those who apply to study at the Faculty of International Studies will be interviewed in English and Chinese or French. The Committee's decision will be made based on the following criteria:

Applicants must receive at least 50% for each criterion and at least 60 points in total to pass the interview. Decisions by the Admissions Committee are final and are not subject to further review or appeal.
